

Notice of Spring Road Restrictions

Please note the message below from Saskatchewan Highways & Infrastructure. All municipal roads in the R.M. of Moose Jaw No. 161 will be subject to spring road weight restrictions (road bans) effective Sunday, Midnight, March 22, 2009 as noted below. Basic weight restrictions are noted below, and depend on the axle configuration of a truck and the maximum GVW allowable as stipulated by the manufacturer.

**Steering Axles - 560 pounds per inch width of tire
All Other Axles - 350 pounds per inch width of tire**

The Council of the R.M. of Moose Jaw No. 161 typically impose spring road bans for a period of three to six weeks. Contact the municipal office for further information in this regard.

Saskatchewan Highways plan to place spring weight restrictions on some provincial highways in the **Moose Jaw Area effective Sunday, Midnight, March 22nd, 2009 (12:01 AM Monday March 23, 2009)**. This order will be published on Friday March 20th, 2009. Any changes to the order must be received no later than noon Thursday, March 19th, 2009.

In accordance with current policy, all rural municipalities are automatically included in the restriction orders unless the municipality opts out. If you do not wish to be included with the Order, please notify this office if you have not already done so.

Orders are published each Tuesday and Friday morning, excluding Good Friday, so any changes must be in to the Area Office by noon the day before publication. Your municipality may opt in or out of future orders at any time, provided you notify the Area Office with your request. Notification must be in the form of a letter or fax from the Administrator or the Road Committee.

Spring road restrictions are weather dependant and the decision to implement these restrictions is subject to change. You will be notified if there are any changes to this date.
