- (b) Offsite development levies shall be applied and charged by the City of Moose Jaw to the total number of land acres to be developed under the approved development permit (herein described as 'defined benefitting area') and any undeveloped land acres outside the defined benefitting area shall be exempt from the charging and payment of off-site development levies until such time the undeveloped land acres, or any portion thereof, are further being subdivided and/or developed under a new development permit application. The City shall be entitled to register a caveat on the land title to secure interest in the deferment of off-site development levy charges that would apply should further development and/or subdivision be undertaken;
- (c) A Building Permit shall be applied for through the City of Moose Jaw including a detailed site plan, detailed parking plan, drainage and grading plans and servicing plan;
- (d) Approval from Nav Canada authorizing the construction and operation of the facility via the "Land Use Submission Form".
