## Bylaw No. 6/2001

## A BYLAW TO ENFORCE THE USE OF COVERS ON VEHICLES TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF NOXIOUS WEEDS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Jaw No. 161 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

This Bylaw shall be known as the <i>Tarping Bylaw</i> .
Before any grain, forage/fodder, field crop seeds, crushed grain or cleanings of any kind, excepting silage and products that are wrapped, bagged or baled, while being moved within the municipality, shall be covered in such a manner as to prevent the spread of noxious weeds during such movement.
Whether loaded or not, trucks/units used to transport any of the materials mentioned in section 2 of this bylaw shall ensure that:  boxes are covered with a securely fastened tarpaulin or similar cover when
moving anywhere within the Municipality,  AND
i) chutes are securely fastened when unit is moving anywhere within the municipality.
A legible card containing the provision of this bylaw are to be conspicuously posted in all grain elevators, seed cleaning plants and seed warehouses within the municipality.
Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars as provided under the <i>Noxious Weeds Act</i> , 1984 and amendments thereto.
6 Bylaw No. 129 is hereby repealed.
