

## Bylaw No. 42

### A Bylaw to Restrict the Discharge of Firearms, Airguns or Explosives

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Jaw No. 161, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw, the expression “**firearm**” includes any rifle, fowling piece, pistol, revolver, airgun or explosives.
2. Within the Rural Municipality of Moose Jaw No. 161, no person shall discharge any firearm without first having obtained written permission from the owner or occupant of the land over or on which the discharge is to take place.
3. This Bylaw shall not apply to the discharge of a firearm by a person on land of which said person is in actual occupation; or to the discharge of a firearm by a member of the family of a person on land of which such person is in actual occupation; or to the discharge of a firearm during the open season by a person who is the holder of a license to hunt big game or game birds, issued to such person under the provision of *The Game Act* of the Province of Saskatchewan.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
